
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# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

# 4240/4260 SERIES STROBE LIGHTS

<u>DANGER</u> WAIT <u>FIVE (5) MINUTES</u> BEFORE REMOVING THE STROBE LIGHT LENS IF THE STROBE LIGHT HAS BEEN OPERATED. THE POWER SUPPLY CONTAINS <u>LETHAL</u> VOLTAGES WHICH MUST DISCHARGE.

## STROBE LIGHT INSTALLATION:

The Strobe Light is intended for commercial use and should be installed and maintained by qualified personnel. Position the unit to avoid damage and protect as required. Ensure the location provides for function as intended and does not interfere with operator's safe operation of the vehicle.

Use the Base (Item 6 or 14) as a template to mark the mounting surface and drill three (four; HB4280) 7/32" diameter holes for the Mounting Screws (Item 7) and one 3/8" diameter hole in the center for the Grommet (Item 9).

- Route 18 AWG wires, in a protected fashion, in accordance with the vehicle manufacturer's instructions, to the strobe mounting location. It is recommended to install a 10 amp fuse in-line for wire run protection. (Note: For runs over 20 feet, consult local electrical codes.)
  3. Install the Grommet (Item 9) into the 3/8" hole in the mounting surface.
- Route wires through the Grommet (Item 9) and through the Gasket (Item 8) as shown.
- Connect the Strobe Light to the wire run using the Splice Terminals (Item 12) provided. The red wire to positive and the black wire to negative. (Note: If this connection is reversed, the light will not operate. However, it will not cause damage to the strobe.)
- Test the Strobe Light operation before proceeding.
- Mount the Strobe Light on the vehicle and tighten the mounting hardware (Item 7, 10 and 11) as shown. (Note: If using Polycarbonate High Skirt (Item 14), also tighten Base Skirt Screws (Item 13))
- If using another mounting method, refer to the instructions with that mounting kit.

Check the Strobe Light for proper operation daily and log in the maintenance record.

## 1" NPT PIPE MOUNTING:

Feed the power leads through the pipe and connect to the Strobe Light same as the above instructions. Screw the Strobe Light onto the pipe threads, the Base (Item 6) is already threaded, taking care not to damage the power leads. (Note: 1" pipe has an approximately 1-1/4" outer diameter.)

## **WEATHER-PROOF INSTALLATIONS:**

After the Strobe Light is mounted and connected, turn OFF and WAIT FIVE (5) MINUTES. Remove the Lens (Item 1) from the Base (Item 6) and set aside. Remove the three retaining screws (Item 4) and lift the Power Supply (Item 5). Seal the wire exit hole in the Base (Item 6) with non-corrosive caulk (such as Permatex FormaGasket No. 2). Reassemble the Strobe Light. Ensure the O-Ring Seal (Item 2) is installed as shown. In extremely humid climates, leaving the wire exit hole unsealed may keep the inside of the unit drier than if the hole is completely sealed. (Note: It may be necessary for the installer to seal the mounting holes and wire run hole in the mounting surface for a weather-proof seal. Proper fastener sealing will help prevent moisture from entering the vehicle through the mounting holes.)

## IN CASE OF TROUBLE:

If the Strobe Light stops operating suddenly, first ensure it is getting power, 9.8 VDC min. to 36.4 VDC max. If the power to the Strobe Light is correct, then the internal fuse may be blown and the Strobe Light may need repair or replacement. Turn OFF the Strobe Light power AND WAIT FIVE (5) MINUTES. Remove the Lens (Item 1) and inspect the Flash-Tube Assembly (Item 3) and Power Supply (Item 5). If any burned or extremely corroded areas are visible, replace the Flash-Tube Assembly (Item 3) or Strobe Light. Do not grasp the glass Flash-Tube (Item 3). Reassemble the Strobe Light. Follow the directions below.

# REPLACEMENT OF FLASH TUBE:

The glass Flash-Tube (Item 3) will darken with operation and eventually need replacement. Turn OFF the Strobe Light AND WAIT FIVE (5) MINUTES. Remove the Lens (Item 1) and set aside. Remove the Flash-Tube Assembly (Item 3), squeezing

inward on the tabs and pulling straight upward, from the Power Supply (Item 3). Do not rock the assembly or grasp the glass Flash-Tube (Item 3). Inspect the tube pins and supply sockets for corrosion, clean with isopropyl alcohol if necessary. If the corrosion is extreme, replace the Strobe Light. Plug a new Flash-Tube Assembly (Item 3) into the Power Supply (Item 5), insuring tabs positively latch. Note the Flash-Tube Assembly (Item 3) is polarized and may only be inserted in one direction. Clean the inside of the Lens (Item 1) and the Power Supply (Item 5) with isopropyl alcohol. Allow parts to dry completely and reassemble ensuring the Lens (Item 1) and O-Ring (Item 2) are assembled tightly and fit correctly. If necessary lubricate the O-ring (Item 2) with Silicone oil or grease.

The Preco 4241 and 4261 are double-flash Strobe Lights packaged in a durable die-cast aluminum base with a removable lens, modular vibration-resistant power supply and field-replaceable flash-tube. The HB4280 also allows the incorporation of a polycarbonate skirt. This Strobe Light is designed for 12 and 24 Volt Systems without modifications or adjustment. The 424X is 4-11/16" high with a base diameter of 6-7/16". The 426X is 6-1/4" high with a base diameter of 6-7/16". The 426X with HB4280 is 8-11/16" high with a skirt diameter of 8-3/8". Amber (Yellow), Clear (White), Red. Green and Signal Blue lens colors are available, consult factory for order part numbers.


